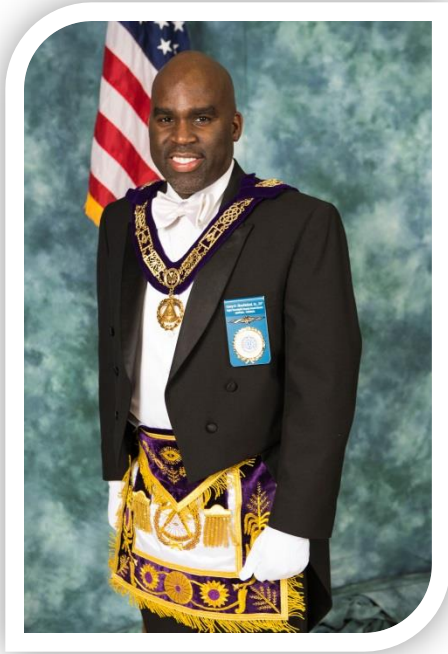


**RW Corey D. Shackelford, Sr.
